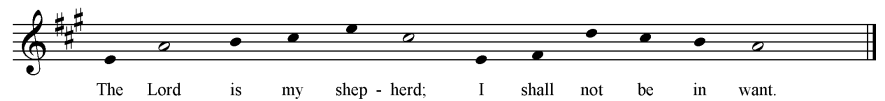


May 17th at 11:15am

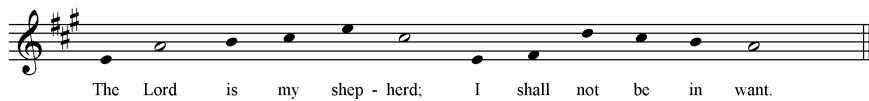
