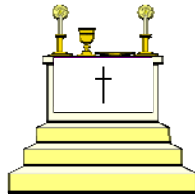

Do you read/speak another language? Would you be willing to share that gift with your church family?

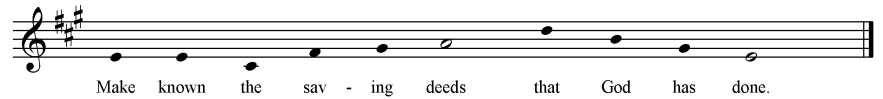
Pentecost is Sunday, **May 20th**

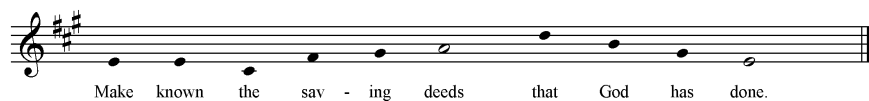
