Join Us For the 8th Annual Camp Caroline! June 21st - September 6th

What is Camp Caroline?

Camp Caroline is an extension of our school year children's program. During Camp Caroline, your children will have the opportunity to learn more about the Christian faith through stories, arts and crafts, songs, and games.

How Does it Work?

Come to church during the summer and bring your children into church with you. Right before the sermon (about 20 minutes into the service), the Camp Caroline teachers will stand up in the aisle. All children, ages 4 through fourth grade, will be invited to stand up and will be led out of the church to the downstairs Parish House where they will participate in a casual, stimulating, fun, hands on summer church program. At the end of church, you can pick up your children from the basement of the Parish House.

We look forward to seeing you and your kids at Camp!
