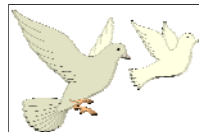

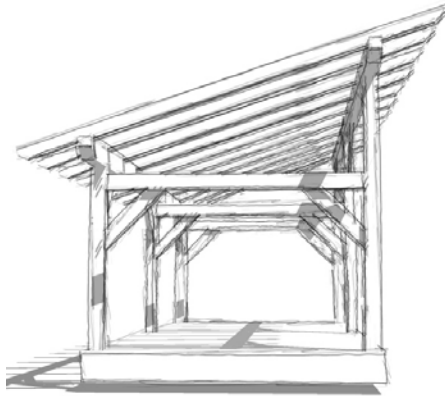
Confirmation Class of 2018
