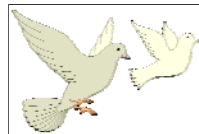

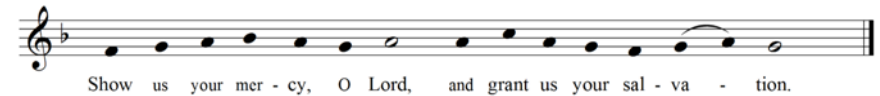


Mitten Tree 'Box'

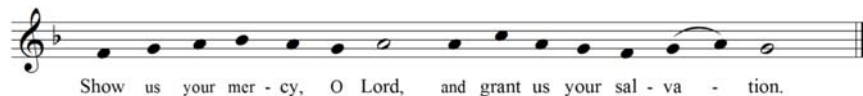

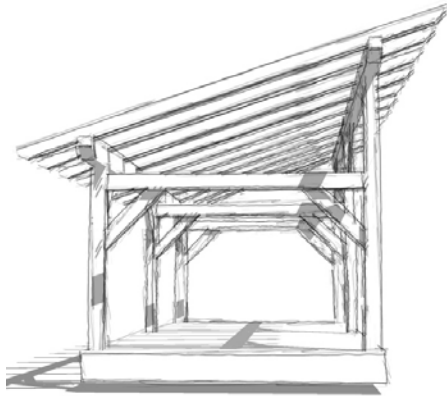
Confirmation Class of 2018
