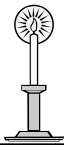

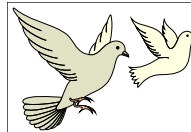

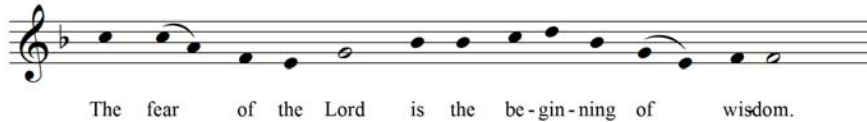

A resolution this month from the Diocesan Council says, "The Bishop and Diocesan Council request that congregations of the Diocese of Long Island join with the Diocese of Maryland to designate the first Sunday of February as a day to generously give to a fund to support the children of Thomas Palermo." Mr. Palermo was the bicyclist killed in the tragic accident involving the Suffragan Bishop of Maryland.

Commenting on the council action, Bishop Provenzano said, "In the spirit of mutual responsibility and interdependence in the church (a call to support and take responsibility for each other's ministry and needs), we ask you to join together with our sisters and brothers in the Diocese of Maryland in making this offering to the Palermo family, a way we can be mutually supportive."

Bishop Knudsen added the reminder that "We are one Church; when one of us suffers, we all suffer."
