SHROVE TUESDAY PANCAKE SUPPER

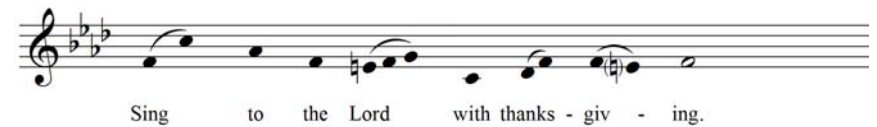

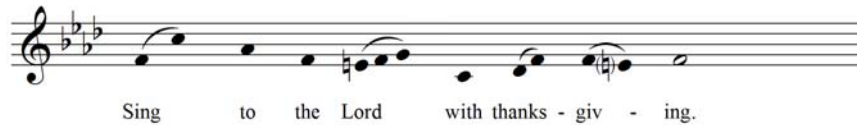
