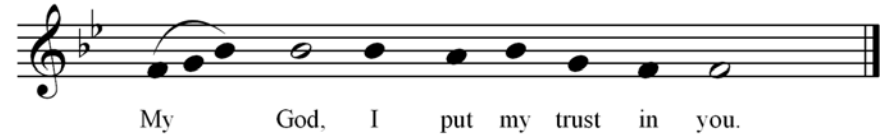
Lent: A Journey of Reflection

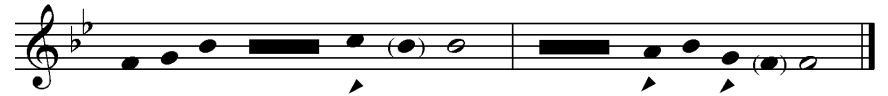
March 4, we will have a soup supper followed by a quiz and presentation about the history and meaning of Lent.

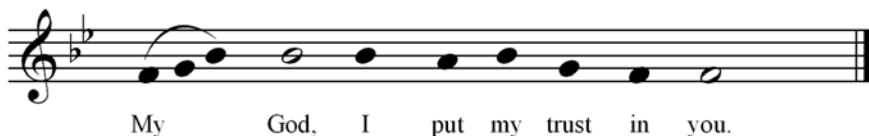

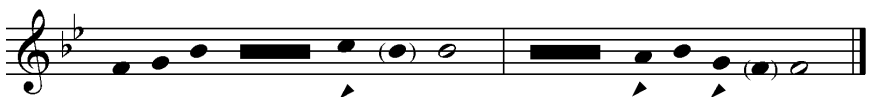
