### English Masters Presentation at The Little Portion Friary

All Souls’ parishioner, Dr. Gregory Alexander, will present English Masters of Cathedral Music, on Saturday, **January 17th**, 2015 at the Little Portion Friary in Mt. Sinai. On this Franciscan Day of Reflection,

Greg will focus on cathedral music of six English composers, beginning with John Taverner, born in the 15th century, and ending with his distant relative, John Tavener, who passed on just last year. We will hear longer and some shorter works of these composers, including motets, mass settings, evening services, hymns and anthems. The other composers featured are Christopher Tye, John Sheppard, Orlando Gibbons and Herbert Howells. Brief introductory comments will be made about the music, composers, and selections. The program will begin at 10 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m., with a Mass and lunch in between. The costs is \$30 which includes lunch.
