Annual Parish Meeting

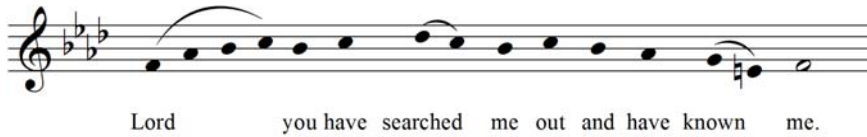

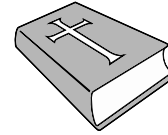
