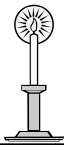

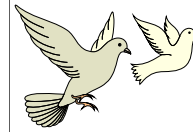

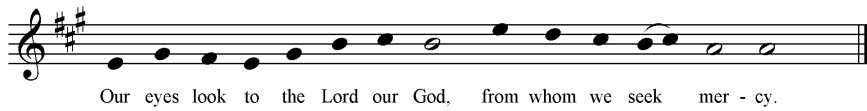

What is Camp Caroline?
