### When is it?

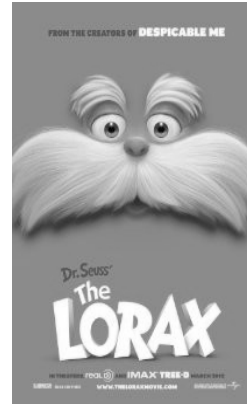
Camp Caroline will run for 12 Sundays, beginning Sunday, June 21st and ending Sunday, September 6th, beginning at 10:00am.
