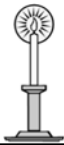

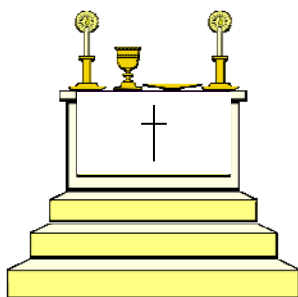

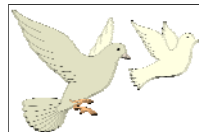

- Become an event Sponsor

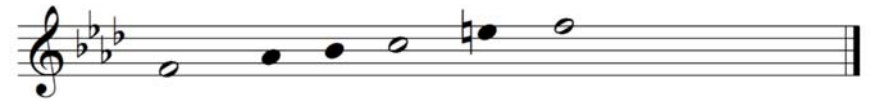
Did you know it costs between \$1200 - \$1400 of out of pocket expense to get the fair started.

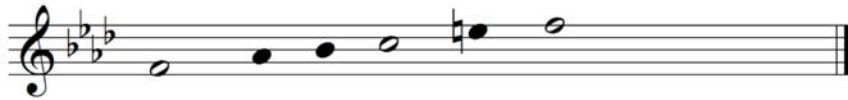
