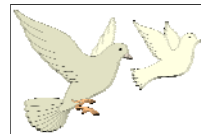

The Three Village Interfaith Clergy Association will be offering its annual Community Interfaith Thanksgiving service on **Tuesday**, November 21 at 7:00 p.m. at Setauket United Methodist Church (160 Main St., East Setauket).
