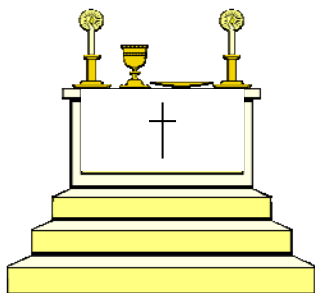

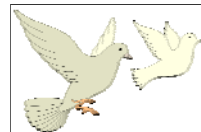

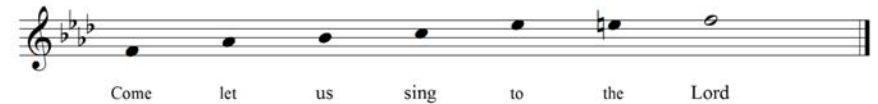

Advent Program: Christianity offers a wealth of spiritual practices to aid in our growth. Among these are various forms of individual and group spiritual direction. Please join us to learn about and practice group spiritual direction on **December 5th** and December 12th at 7:00p.m. in the parish house of Caroline Church. We will begin on December 5th with a short introduction to the various forms of spiritual direction followed by Ignation Group Spiritual Direction. On December 12th, we will have a brief introduction to the Shalem model and will then engage in group spiritual direction based on that model.

2017 Adopt a Family: Caroline Church is again taking part in the Diocesan Adopt a Family program. Tags with requested gifts are posted in the Church vestibule. 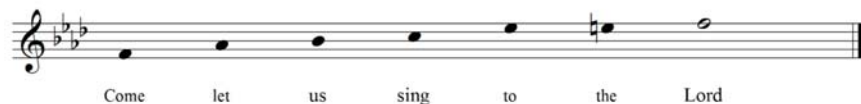

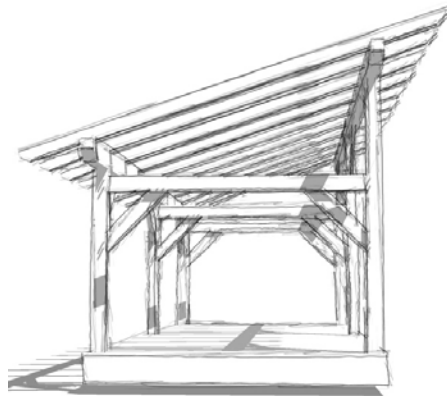
