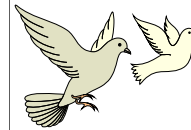

**Adult Education Program: "Borderland"** is a four-part television documentary, produced and aired in April 2014, in which six Americans from varying backgrounds are confronted with the realities of undocumented migrant labor. The six participants split into three groups and go to Mexico and Central America in order to retrace the footsteps of three migrants who did not survive the journey north. They discover the circumstances which led the migrants they are tracing to risk their lives; they make their way north by riding atop a cargo train know as "La Bestia" or "The Beast"; they learn about the impact of Mexico's drug wars on immigrants; they traverse the desert in which some 2500 migrants had died the previous year.

Alex Seel, Sue Seel and Spencer Edelbaum's son (Caroline Church parishioners), was one of the six participants and will be present for question and answer. These presentations are for adults and mature teens.

We will consider two episodes per evening on **October 20th & 27th** beginning at 6:30pm. Undocumented migrant labor is a compelling issue that all Christians face. Come view the documentary and discuss.
