at coffee hour in the MCS building*

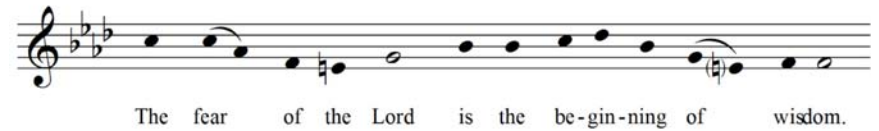
*Deadline to return your box is 11/13.*

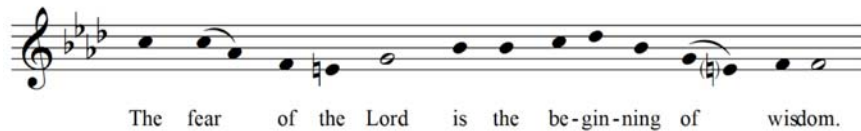
