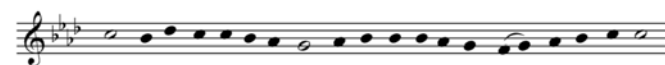

Weekly E-Blasts!

In addition to providing parishioners with the weekly announcements at weekend services, we frequently send out electronic announcements of items that are of general interest and are time sensitive. If you haven't been receiving our weekly "e-blasts" and would like to, it's as simple as going to your computer.
