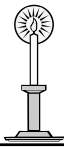

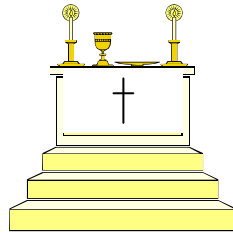

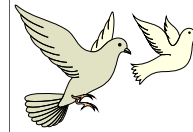

Today Confirmation/Reception At Caroline Church

We Welcome **Bishop Provenzano TODAY at the 10:00am Service**. He will Confirm/Receive six people into the Episcopal branch of the holy Catholic Church. The youth to be Confirmed are Elyse Kady, Maggie Reyes, and Gracie Sobalvarro. The adults are Maureen Reyes and Jean Sobalvarro (Reception), and Nancy Clark of All Souls' (Confirmation). We celebrate the blessing of their presence among us and ask your prayers for all six as they begin the next steps of their Christian journey. We invite you all to join us at a reception immediately following the 10:00am Service in the Marco C. Smith building.

Home Bible Study: The Home Bible Study will meet on **October 19th**, at 7:00pm for refreshments and 7:30pm for our continued study of The Acts of the Apostles. Each week before we begin our study we spend some time sharing articles pertaining to faith found in newspapers or periodicals. All are welcome.

Adult Education Program: "Borderland" is a four-part television documentary, produced and aired in April 2014, in which six Americans from varying backgrounds are confronted with the realities of undocumented migrant labor. The six participants split into three groups and go to Mexico and Central America in order to retrace the footsteps of three migrants who did not survive the journey north. They discover the circumstances which led the migrants they are tracing to risk their lives; they make their way north by riding atop a cargo train know as "La Bestia" or "The Beast"; they learn about the impact of Mexico's drug wars on immigrants; they traverse the desert in which some 2500 migrants had died the previous year.

Alex Seel, Sue Seel and Spencer Edelbaum's son (Caroline Church parishioners), was one of the six participants and will be present for questions and answers. These presentations are for adults and mature teens.

We will consider two episodes per evening on **October 20th & 27th** beginning at 6:30pm. Undocumented migrant labor is a compelling issue that all Christians face. Come view the documentary and discuss.
