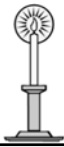

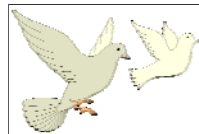

#### **All Saint's and All Souls' Day**

Praying for the departed appears in many places in our Book of Common Prayer. Although there is a weekly opportunity for remembering the dead in the Prayers of the People in the Holy Eucharist, our Prayer Book Calendar lists November 1<sup>st</sup> as All Saints' Day and November 2<sup>nd</sup> as Commemoration of All Faithful Departed—All Souls' Day.

Since our society allows less and less time for grief, the observance of these days are an important part of our pastoral care of the bereaved. We show our solidarity with one another and our love for those who have died, commending them in faith to God. We are continuing fellowship with the faithful departed within the communion of saints and the unsearchable riches of Christ's passion to their existence and ours.

As we have done in previous years, the insert in the *Carillon*, as well as in our Sunday Bulletin has spaces for you to write in the first and last names of any departed you wish to be remembered aloud as part of the intercessions for the Burial of the Dead at our Holy Eucharist Healing service on All Souls' Day, Thursday, November 2nd at 12:00 Noon. The names will also be reproduced in the Sunday bulletin and remembered on All Saints' Sunday, November 5th.

I invite you to put your completed inserts in the offering plate at a Sunday service or return it to the parish office by October 29th.



## Operation Shoe Box Has Begun

Deadline to return your box is **11/12**.

Empty boxes are available to be filled at the back of the church or in the MCS building. Please include small toys or other gifts and label it for a boy or girl and appropriate age. **NEW THIS YEAR:** The shipping price has gone up to **\$9.00 per box**. Please do **NOT** include cash, only checks or you may go online and pay through credit card there. If you go online you will be able to track your box to see which country it is delivered to. Also this year to **NOT** include **toothpaste!!** This project brings joy and hope to children in desperate situations worldwide through gift-filled shoe boxes and the Good News of God's love.

Filled boxes can be dropped off during the week in the Church School office, Main office, or brought in on Sunday mornings to the MCS building. All boxes must be in by **November 12th**, for National Collection Day. If you have any questions please contact the parish office. Thank you.

The parishioners from our sister church, **All Soul's Church**, located in Stony Brook, are joining us at Caroline Church's Sunday Worship Services today, October 22, 2017, due to the street closure for the Stony Brook Walk for Beauty. We welcome them to our services.

**Annual Acolyte Recognition Day:** All Acolytes are asked to attend this year's Annual Day of Recognition of ministry, joining our four new acolytes on Sunday, November 5 at the 9:30 a.m. service. Immediately following the service, there will be a special breakfast and meeting up in the second floor Rector's Conference Room in the MCS building to review procedures and plan for special activities.
