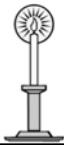

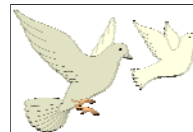

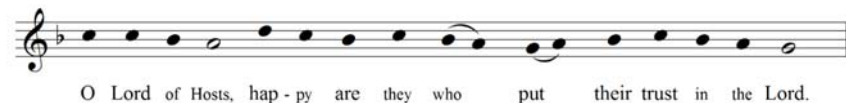
We will be **collating the Carillon** on Monday, **October 31st** at 9:30am in the kitchen of the MCS building.
