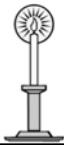

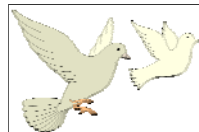

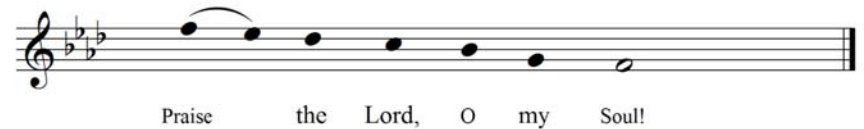
**Blessing of the Animals
