

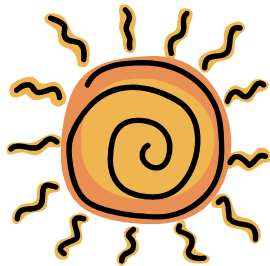
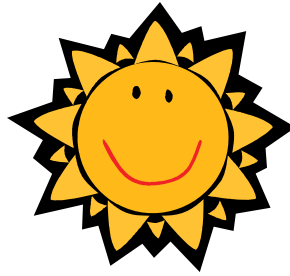

Come To Camp DeWolfe This Summer Summer Camp Schedule

EXPLORER CAMP (ages 7-11): July 7th – July 12th 2013: \$595 per one-week session

A great way to introduce your child to camp! A 6 day camp designed for new elementary campers with taster sessions in activity areas including archery, swimming, and arts. Evening programs and Christian Formation sessions are tailored for new campers to make new friends and learn about God in a safe, fun and outdoor environment.

DISCOVERY CAMP (ages 8-12): July 14th – July 26th 2013: \$1190 per two-week session

An engaging and energetic two-week camp for elementary youth to participate in a range of activities and programs on the Long Island Sound. Campers will be able to explore nature and build friendships, through interactive activities that center on God's love and grace.

ADVENTURE CAMP (ages 12-15): July 28th – August 9th 2013: \$1190 per two-week session

A two-week camp program for middle school youth to enjoy a place apart from the busy world and to experience God's love through nature, community, and challenge. Opportunities to develop skills in activities including sailing, wilderness skills and swimming. Christian Formation programs are designed to encourage youth to discover their faith in an open and caring environment.

LEADERSHIP IN TRAINING (LIT) (ages 15-17): July 7th – August 9th 2013: \$1250 per five-week session (must attend all weeks)

A challenging and advanced camp for high school youth to be empowered to discover their God-given potential and to grow in community. Opportunities to facilitate and lead a day camp program, master activity areas, develop new skills, and live out faith in practical and service-centred ways. Programs include Adventure Challenge workshops, solo reflection, and Christian Formation sessions that encourage youth to find true identity in God and learn how to lead others to Christ.

DAY CAMP: July 8th 2013 – August 9th 2013: Monday – Friday 9am – 5pm: \$350 per five-day session (must register in five-day session periods)

A new Christian Day Camp for campers ages 7 – 14 to be able to enjoy God's creation in the outdoor beach setting and make new friendships in a safe community. Opportunities to try swimming, sailing, kayaking, canoeing, arts, sports and more! 5-day sessions are by age for safety and supervision.

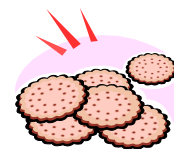

Join Us For the 9th Annual **Camp Caroline!**

What is Camp Caroline?

Camp Caroline is an extension of our school year children's program. During Camp Caroline, your children will have the opportunity to learn more about the Christian faith through stories, arts and crafts, songs, and games.

How does it Work?

Come to church during the summer and bring your children into church with you. Right before the sermon (about 20 minutes into the service), the Camp Caroline teachers will stand up in the aisle. All children, ages 4 through fourth grade, will be invited to stand up and will be led out of the church into the MCS building where they will participate in a casual, stimulating, fun, hands on summer church program. At the end of church, you can pick up your children in the MCS building across the back parking lot.

When is it?

Camp Caroline will run for 12 Sundays, beginning Sunday, June 16th and ending Sunday, September 1st. Remember, starting on June 16th, the usual 9:30am worship service starts one hour later, at 10:00 A.M.

We need both adult and teen volunteers to assist Camp Caroline this summer. Please consider volunteering one Sunday this summer. No experience is necessary. SPEAK OUT AGAINST SEVERE CUTS TO SNAP IN THE FARM BILL!

At the meeting, Island Harvest's Mobilized Coalition Against Hunger (**MICAH**) will discuss ways members can speak out to save **SNAP** from severe cuts in the Farm Bill. SNAP stands for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, formerly known as Food Stamps.

MICAH is urging the entire Long Island community to speak out against the House Agriculture Committee's vote to slash spending on SNAP by \$21 billion.

Please attend the June 3rd meeting to help lead MICAH's Advocacy efforts in the fight to save SNAP for those who need it!

Cuts to SNAP:

- Nationally two million people will lose benefits entirely
- 210,000 kids will lose access to free school meals
- Another 850,000 households will see their benefits cut by an average of \$90 per month.
- These cuts will be in addition to across-the-board cuts for all SNAP beneficiaries beginning in November that will lower benefits by about \$25 for a family of three

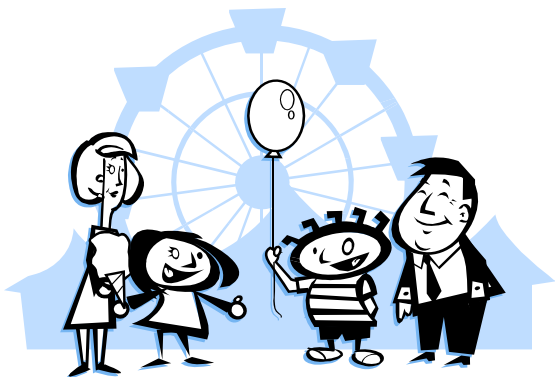
Action You Can Take to Save SNAP:

Did You Know?

SNAP benefits average less than \$1.50 per person per meal, and over 90 percent of benefits are spent by day 21 of the month, leaving many families to turn to local charities to make ends meet. SNAP is targeted at our most vulnerable: 76 percent of SNAP households include a child, elderly person, or disabled person, and 91 percent of benefits go to households with gross income at or below 100 percent of the poverty line.
