## Buildings & Grounds

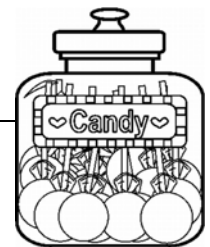
Spring finally arrived, with the bulbs blooming shortly after Easter. The daffodils are doing well and apparently the tulips were also a hit—at least with the deer who consumed them as fast as they bloomed.

Old Field Landscape has mulched the beds, and soon their mowers will spring to life. Sunburst Tree Service has done the first dormant oil spray and spring fertilization of our ornamental trees and shrubs. They have identified some minor pruning that is needed in several spots, but the trees seem to have come through the winter in pretty good shape. The sprinklers have been tested, some breaks from the snowplows repaired, and they are ready to go when needed.

Valley Restoration returned for a day last month to touch up spots that became visible when the new gutters & downspouts were installed. They will also be making some recommendations on how to deal with the streaks that are appearing on the bell tower.

By the time you read this, the Buildings & Grounds Committee will have met to do some planning. One of the top priorities this season is to get some repairs made to broken and toppled tombstones. We continue to explore options for the carriage shed, which appears to have made it through the winter without further significant deterioration.

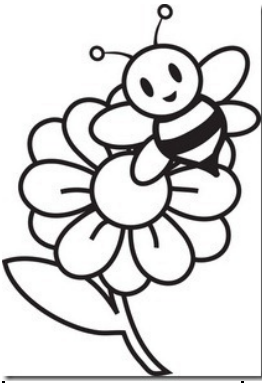
